**OK DINGHY 2010
EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP**

NOTICE OF RACE

The Royal Yacht Club Hollandia takes pleasure in inviting you to participate in the OK DINGHY 2010 EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP which will be held from 24 till 30 July 2010, inclusive and will be sailed on the IJsselmeer off Medemblik, the Netherlands.

The Organizing Authority is the Royal Yacht Club Hollandia.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the OK Dinghy class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by registration with the Organizing Authority.
- 3.3 Entries shall be made on the website: www.ryc-hollandia.org
- 3.4 Entry closes at 14 July 2010
- 3.3 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: an additional entry fee of € 50.

5 FEES

- 5.1 The Entry fee is € 195
- 5.2 Other fees: dinner tickets for accompanying persons will be available. The price will be announced later.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1. All competitors must register before 1800 on Sunday July 25, even if they have previously submitted an entry. No boat's entry will be complete until all forms are submitted , measurement check is completed and all fees paid.

- 6.2 One evening a dinner party will be organised (not on Friday evening).
- 6.3 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be given after 1500.

7 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

Additional measurement checks to be made include, but are not limited to, spars, rudders, centreboards, mast and sails.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 0900 on July 24 at the regatta office.

9 VENUE

- 9.1 Attachment 1 shows the location of the regatta harbour.
- 9.2 Attachment 2 shows the location of the racing areas.

10 THE COURSES

The course will be a triangular course including windward, reaching and leeward marks in compliance with the OKDIA constitution. Course diagrams will be supplied with the Sailing Instructions.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

No international jury will be appointed.

12 SCORING

12.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

12.2 (a) When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from five to ten races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13 SUPPORT BOATS

13.1 Coaches, team leaders and representatives from participating nations shall be registered at the Regatta Office before the first racing day.

13.2 Support boats shall fly their national flag or a flag with their three national letters clearly displayed, or shall be permanently marked with a sticker of their national flag or of their three national letters on each side of the boat.

14 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park.

15 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

16 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

The winner will receive the Euro Cup (perpetual prize).

Prizes for helmsman ranked in place 1-10 in the regatta.

The Sailing Instructions may specify more prizes.

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent.

19 HOUSING AND CAMPERS/CARAVANS

Regulations in the Netherlands prohibit sleeping in campers and caravans parked along public roads or in public car parks.

On the designated area of the RCM harbour competitors may sleep in tents, caravans or campers, provided a fee of € 2.50 per person per night (tourists tax) will be paid to the City of Medemblik. The fee is payable at the regatta office upon registration.

20 REGATTA OFFICE

The regatta office inside the ISCM will be open for registration from 24 July 0900.
